### Covid—Update on Restrictions in School

Schools in the county have received further advice from The Regional Group and Gloucestershire County Council:

**'Although rates have started to decline in Gloucestershire, they are still concerningly high, with current rates above both regional and national averages. The regional group are therefore recommending that measures are maintained at least until the end of November.'**

We will be participating in the Children In Need appeal this Friday. Children are welcome to dress in any outfit for a suggested donation of 50p to the appeal.

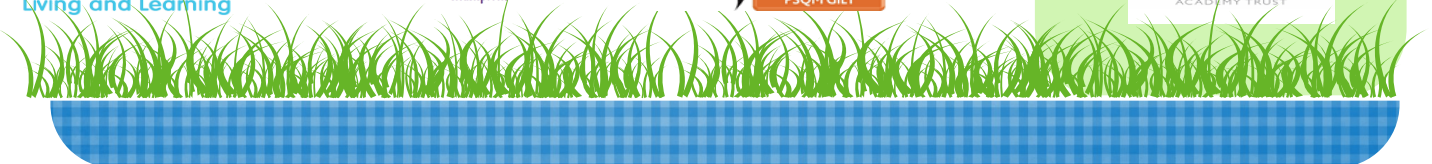
### **Blitz Those Nits!**
