Free School Meals

Under the current Coronavirus situation, if your financial circumstances have changed and you are now entitled to Universal Credit, or if you believe you are entitled to free school meals and have not previously applied, you can apply for free school meals online, via the Gloucestershire County Council website. Click on 'Education and Learning' and then on 'School Transport and Free School Meals'. This will give you a list of criteria for eligibility to apply. If any of these apply to you, click on the button stating 'Apply Online'. This will take you through the application and you will be informed almost immediately whether you are eligible. The school will then be informed if your child has been registered as Free School Meals.
