Coronavirus—SCHOOL CLOSED FROM TODAY

To ensure children receive some form of education whilst away from school, the teachers have been uploading resources for children to access at home. There will be new resources for the children to access every week, if not daily, and children are encouraged to message their teacher through the VLE as a checkpoint, or if they need help.

The School will only be open to those children—reference letter sent by Woodfield site. The school will not be operating normal lessons and those pupils that attend the sessions will not be in their classes or with their usual teachers. We will be operating a skeleton staff during this emergency provision. This can only be maintained if staffing levels are safe to do so. Further updates and any other information received from the Government will be circulated.
