### VLE – (Virtual Learning Environment)

From September, all parents will have the facility to pay for lunches, trips or special events for their child on the VLE's epay section. You will also be able to view the hot lunch menu and select your child's meals.

Further information and step by step guides for the VLE will be published and circulated to parents.

Please note: we will not be using the Parent Pay or Parent Mail from September 2019, this will all be done through the VLE system. There will also be a period of transition for parents to familiarise themselves with the system – so please do not worry if you cannot access the pay facility straightaway, we will take this into consideration. If you do have monies in credit with Parent Pay, then CBAT will look into this and arrange a transfer – if applicable.

With any new handover of system or processes, there might be a few teething problems to start with, especially as it is a whole school change. All we ask is that you are patient with us, in trying to rectify any 'Gremlins' that may arise. Thank you.
