




Co-ordinating conjunctions join two main clauses together.

Subordinating Conjunctions

Here are 10 of the most common subordinating conjunctions. They are used at the beginning of a subordinating clause which is a clause that doesn't make sense on its own.



Subordinating conjunctions join a main clause and subordinating clause together.

Subordinating clauses are clauses that don't make sense on their own.
